Yahshua the Messiah answered: "Watch out and do not let anyone fool you. Many men claiming to speak for me, will come and say, 'I am the Messiah' and they will fool many people. They will try to deceive even the elect or chosen of God."

“Sin, Grace and Glory Beyond Compare”

“For all have seen and come short of the glory of the Almighty Yahweh” Romans 3:23

“In the same way you are to think of yourselves as dead, so far as sin is concerned, but living in fellowship with Almighty Yahweh through His Son Yahshua the Messiah (Jesus Christ)” Romans 6:11

“Those who are led by Almighty Yahweh’s Spirit are God’s children. For the Spirit that Almighty Yahweh has given you does not make you slaves and cause you to be afraid, instead the Spirit makes you God’s children, and by the Spirit’s power we cry out to God “ Father, my Father !” Almighty Yahweh’s Spirit joins himself to our spirits to declare that we are God’s children. Since we are His children, we will possess the blessings He keeps for his people, and we will also possess with Yahshua the Messiah (Jesus Christ) what God has kept for him; for if we share Yahshua the Messiah’s (Jesus Christ’s) suffering, we will also share his glory.” Romans 8: 14-18

From the verses in the book of Romans, I would like to share about 3 points: sin, not living in sin but in grace and glory beyond compare.

SIN. WE ARE ALL SINNERS. Mankind have displeased Almighty Yahweh since the beginning of time, that is when, Adam and Eve have committed sin in the Garden of Eden. But our Heavenly Father Yahweh’s love is so great that in spite of our weaknesses as humans He continues to care for us- He never gave up on us – as David the Psalmist says “He remembers what we are made of; He remembers that we are dust”. Parents have a glimpse of this wonderful love that the

Almighty Yahweh has for His people. Parents have great love for their children – this love is beyond description and comparison.

Parents know how and what it is to never give up on their children. Almighty Yahweh's love is greater and bigger than a parents' love for their children. God has never and will never give up on us, instead, He sent his only Son Yahshua the Messiah to save us. John 3 :16 states " For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believes on Him should not perish but will have everlasting life".

This is a precious and wonderful gift from the Almighty Yahweh. I wish all of us take this precious gift with utmost seriousness and care. This gift is for free, it comes supposedly with man's responsibility to accept this gift of salvation. Once we have received this gift of salvation, let us remember that with it God gave us the authority to be called His sons/children.

Romans 8:15 states "for you have not received a Spirit of slavery bringing you into fear again rather you have received a Spirit of sonship in which we cry, Abba Father!" Let us celebrate for having been given this gift of salvation and of sonship. Also, I would like to take opportunity to remind us not to forget to remain humble and grateful. Such humility and gratefulness spring from the fact that we could not have saved ourselves on our own– not with anything we have, not simply with our good deeds more so not with our wealth.

My brothers and sisters, this leads me into my second insight "***NOT LIVING IN SIN BUT IN GRACE***". Having had this salvation means we live by grace. The Scripture says "Do not be dead in sin but be alive into Almighty Yahweh through Yahshua the Messiah (or Jesus Christ)". Friends, do not waste the salvation that God has given us. Make our Heavenly Father proud and happy of you so that the death of His Son Yahshua

the Messiah (or Jesus Christ) will not be in vain. How do we glorify God?

Not in grandeur things or actions but in day to day service to Him that leads to the fulfilment of His perfect plan or will for our lives here on earth and even beyond. Remember the very simple yet strong verse in Micah 6:8 “what does the Almighty Yahweh require of thee? But to do justly, to love mercy and to walk humbly with thy God”.

Remember this again, we are NOT God’s slaves – we are his children – claim that! We do not wrongfully boast of that but with humility and courage we face this cruel world with the assurance that we are God’s children – and that He is in us, for us and with us always. Hebrews 13:5, “Almighty Yahweh says I will never leave you nor forsake you” and Matthew 28: 20 “I am with you always to the end of the age.”

GLORY BEYOND COMPARE. The gift of Almighty Yahweh’s salvation gives us that hope of a wonderful life beyond compare. Do not get me wrong, as Yahweh’s children, we will not automatically become immune to trials and temptations in this world rather, in rough and tough times we have the assurance that the Lord has overcome the world for us “be of good cheer I have overcome the world”. It is our share to hold tight to Him that we may not let go of His grace, of that branding to be His children. As God’s heirs, so long as we endure, we have that promise of life eternal – of glory beyond compare.

Remember the Scriptures “Since we are His children, we will possess the blessings he keeps for his people, and we will also possess with Yahshua the Messiah (Jesus Christ) what God has kept for him; for if we share Yahshua the Messiah’s (Jesus Christ’s) suffering, we will also share his glory.”

You Are Our God! Save Us!

2 Chronicles 20:1-22

The story of King Jehoshaphat shows us how to have confidence in crisis- not confidence in ourselves but confidence in the Almighty Father. There were three things Jehoshaphat did when he heard horrifying news that a vast army is coming against him from Edom, from the other side of the sea and their lives were in danger. What did Jehoshaphat do? He did three things: He sought the Almighty, heard the Almighty and praised the Almighty Father.

When King Jehoshaphat knew of the news, he resolved to inquire of Yahweh Almighty. He recognized his great need, so he prayed and called for prayer. King as he was he could have run to his armies, he could have been panicky, angry or complaining but Jehoshaphat did what was right; he called on God. Rather than trusting his armies, he publicly admits his lack of strength and calls on God as his only help in crisis. Instead of being panicky and complaining, he prayed.

He put prayer first. He realized that he could do some things after he had prayed, but he could do nothing worthwhile before he prayed. He recognized that prayer was his strongest weapon. He resisted human tendency to panic, get angry or trust in armies. This is very humbling for King Jehoshaphat but he did what was right and best. Verse 12 says, you are our God! We have no power to face this army that is attacking us. We don't know what to do, but our eyes are upon you.

The second thing Jehoshaphat did was to hear the Almighty. King Jehoshaphat, after he prayed, he listened. Verse 15-17 say, "Do not be afraid or discouraged because of this vast army for the battle is not yours but God's. Tomorrow, march down against them. They will be climbing up by the

Pass of Ziz, and you will find them at the end of the gorge in the Desert of Jeruel. You will not have to fight this battle. Take up your positions; stand firm and see the deliverance the Lord will give you, Oh Judah and Jerusalem. Do not be afraid, do not be discouraged. Go out to face them tomorrow, and the Lord will be with you.

The third thing that King Jehoshaphat did was to praise the Elohim. He had faith that the battle could be won not by their own power but by their faith and praise of the Elohim. King Jehoshaphat in verse 20 said, “put your trust in the Lord your God, and you will stand your ground. Believe in what his prophets tell you, and you will succeed.” They gave thanks to the Elohim, verse 21. Then verse 22 declare the victory of Jehoshaphat.

Like King Jehoshaphat and many other successful characters in the Bible, let us seek, hear and praise our God whatever we go through. It is not easy to keep calm in times of crisis human as we are but I know we can. Let us remember that these crises enrich us spiritually because we recognize that apart from God we can do nothing. We cannot rely on our own but on HIM alone for our victory.

When we face challenges, let us run to God. Let us be reminded of who God is. The scripture says, “be still and know that I am God.” As God did to the people in the past, he will also do the same with us. Let us fix our eyes and put our faith in Him. When we run to God, he also gives us His special words; words of assurance and encouragement. When faced with challenges, let us give thanks. Thessalonians 5:17 says, In everything give thanks for this is the will of God.

The first of the seven last words of Yahshua the Messiah is found in Luke 23:34, Yahshua the Messiah said: "Forgive them, Father! They don't know what they are doing."

Second Chances

(2nd last words of Yahshua the Messiah)

Luke 23: 43 Yahshua the Messiah said truly I say to you ,
“Today you shall be with me in Paradise”

The verse in Luke 23:43, “today you’ll be with me in paradise tells us of the story of second chances. If you recall that during the Holy week particularly in the event of “7 last words”, we commemorate the life and suffering of Yahshua the Messiah. We are then reminded of the story of Yahsuha the Messiah hanging on the cross with two robbers. One robber, quite arrogant and adamant maybe to get out of that painful and shameful experience, challenged and mockingly said to Yahshua the Messiah “If you are really the king of the Jews, come down from the cross, save yourself and us”. Meanwhile, the other robber named Dismas or Dimas, had a more humble and repentant heart reprimanded the other robber by saying “Have you no fear of the almighty Yahweh? Indeed we have been condemned justly for the sentence we have corresponds to our crimes. Yet this man has done no crime”. Then, he paid his respect to Yahshua the Messiah and simply said “please remember me in Paradise”. With that, Yahshua the Messiah seeing the goodness and meekness of his heart said to him “Truly I say to you, today you’ll be with me in Paradise.”

Brethren in the faith, the story gives us three insights. First, we all have sinned; second, our Heavenly

Father Yahweh is an ever loving and forgiving God and third, there is a promise of eternal life in true repentance.

First, we all have sinned. Romans 3:23 states “For all have sinned and come short of the glory of our Heavenly Father Yahweh” and in Romans 3:10 “There is none righteous, no, not one”. We are all sinners; we may not be robbers like the ones hanging on the cross with Yahshua the Messiah yet we are all sinners. In small and big ways we have fallen short from the glory of our Father in Heaven. Because of that, we are not exempted from the punishment of our sins. Romans 6:23 mentions “For the wages of sin is death but the gift of our Heavenly Father Yahweh is eternal life through Yahshua the Messiah, our Saviour and King.” Heavenly Father Yahweh cares and loves us so much. He does not want that anyone would perish but that everyone may have everlasting life and may have it abundantly. The gift of life that Apostle Paul has written in Romans 6:23 leads us to the second insight and truth that “Our Father in Heaven Yahweh so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believes in Him would not perish but have everlasting life” (John 3: 16).

Romans 5:8 “But God demonstrates His own love toward us and that while we were yet sinners Yahshua the Messiah died for us”. Our Heavenly Father gave us everything so He could save us, His people. Nobody loves us unconditionally like our Father in Heaven

Yahweh. Let us, therefore, grab this wonderful opportunity to bathe in His love that we maybe called His children and take pleasure in the privileges that His children enjoy – abundant life. This insight on peaceful and abundant life bring us to the third insight, Our Heavenly Father Yahweh always – and will always – gives His children second, third, fourth chances to repent for their sins that they may experience eternal life. He understands our limitations; He knows we are dust. One of the first few steps to salvation is acknowledging to ourselves that we are sinners and that we need our Father in Heaven to save us. Romans 10:13 declare “For whoever calls upon the name of Yahweh Almighty will be saved”. Ephesians 6:8 says “For it is by grace you have been saved through faith – and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of Almighty Yahweh”. Let us claim this gift.

Let us therefore learn from the story of the two robbers hanged on the cross with Yahshua the Messiah. Let us particularly remember that it is never too late to repent; to come back to our Father in Heaven. We are sinners but through the grace of our Father in Heaven Yahweh and through the blood of His Son Yahshua the Messiah we have been saved that we may have life eternal. Believe you have been saved. Amen.

John 19: 26-27

Matthew 27:46

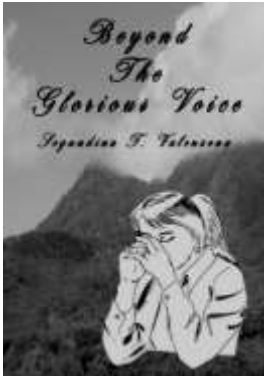

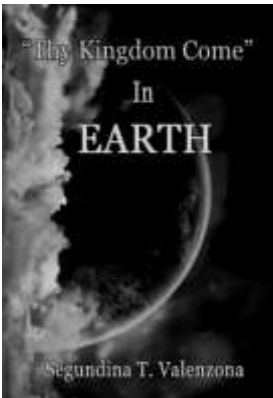

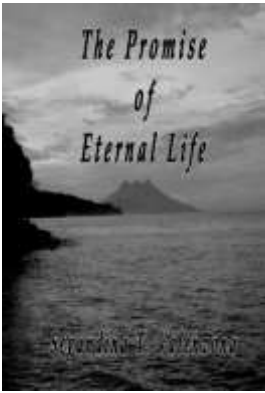
